GCSE Support Programme

Following a successful launch in 2017, we are now running our GCSE Support Programme every year, for students in Years 10 and 11.

Any existing student entering Year 10 will now automatically be enrolled into the GCSE Support Programme, so we can give them targeted support, right up until their exams.

Remember that the new grading systems are now in place, so GCSE results will come in the form of grades from 9 to 1, instead of A* to G and the material on which they will be examined will be much more demanding than previously.

What is the GCSE Support Programme?

Set up to specifically support the new curriculum (first examined in 2017), the programmes are made up of a series of threads (e.g. Algebra or Writing for Impact) that we will build, with each student, from their current level to the best standard that they can achieve by the time of their exams.

All threads are underpinned by the reinforcement of essential core skills – with programmes created for each individual.

The number of places on the GCSE Support Programmes is strictly limited. Existing students are automatically enrolled, but very few spaces remain for new students who are starting Years 11 or 10.

How does it work?

Any existing MagiKats student has the option to continue their regular routine, or to switch to the “double workshop” system:

- Students attend an 80-minute workshop (double the normal length)
- They complete core work, either at home or the centre, each week

This is the only option for new students, joining in Year 11, and optional for new students joining in Year 10.



I am new to MagiKats, what should I do to find out more?

Step one: Give us a call to find out if we have any places available and to ask any questions that you may have.

Step two: Come to the centre for a placement test to establish the core standard of the potential student.

Step three: We discuss suitable attendance patterns in relation to the work to be done.

Step four: There's a little bit of paperwork and then we are up and running.
